GENERAL BUSINESS

- Angela requested that if anyone could not buy toys for the Bravery Box then they could donate money.
- Phil Ryan presented five relocation options for discussion.
 - Option 1 Shared facility with Palmyra Drag Club. They are moving towards a new clubhouse and we could share the costs by way of a weekly rent. At present there is no storage room for us.
 - Option 2 Old Mackay Airport facility. They do have another 2 interested parties who both require airport access so this will be their priority. If available, we could move in in January 2021.
 - Option 3 MRC have 2 options. One being the Tourist Information Centre on Nebo Road and the second is the old Blow Cart Club grounds in South Mackay near Far Beach. Council is looking for a 10-year lease on both facilities and Phil requested documentation to bid on them. The old tourist centre has a good shared public car park with public toilets. We would be responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of the building. The grounds in South Mackay is approximately 40,000 square metres with room to run events plus a shed for storage.
 - Option 4 Mackay Aero Club. Utilise existing club and pay minimum of \$100 per meeting or until the Aero Club considers we spend enough each meeting to cover their costs. There are no storage facilities.
 - Option 5 Mackay Port Authority. Awaiting response to see if we can share the old Surf Life Saving building.
- Tim mentioned to get behind the calendars and pre order.
- Andy Degaura said that with the funds raised from the Variety Bash they were able to buy a wheelchair for a child in Mackay.
