TAC REPORT Tim Bartrop

Inspections were suspended but restarted last month and every 2nd Saturday at present @ Shed 27.
 A senior TMR dept. head has retired, prompting his replacement & Standards Dept. to conduct a review of the Qld. Street Rod Scheme. A questionnaire was sent to Col about our Scheme, enquiring about our feelings with regard to the NSRG among other matters. W.A., A.C.T., Qld, S. A. & Tas are basically all running NSRG, so if the W.A. scheme was adopted in place of our current LH 9 / 10 codes, we wouldn't

see much, if any impact. Observance of VSB14 wouldn't be any good for Qld as Wheel Track, Engine Emission, Padded Dashes, Power/Weight Limits would cripple our ability to build our vehicles. Our Pre-Approved Swaps & Brake Tests wouldn't comply and T buckets & RHS chassis would also become ICV.

Tim replied to them, on Col's behalf, explaining the History of the Qld TAC and how ALL our 25 Inspectors are now Certified and Retrained and we have 3 Licenced Engineers to oversee Approvals.

Tim & Col are still waiting on a response and hope to have a Face-to-face meeting shortly.

GENERAL BUSINESS

Brian Gladman has offered to buy the Raffle trailer which he built using a trailer he owned and has been paying the registration on. A comparable trailer is worth approx.. \$4,000 so the DC decided to offer it to him , for \$2,000.

Unfortunately accommodation costs in Caloundra are increasing by a large amount with no discount for Entrants even though we're the only reason the town is so busy that weekend.
